Background



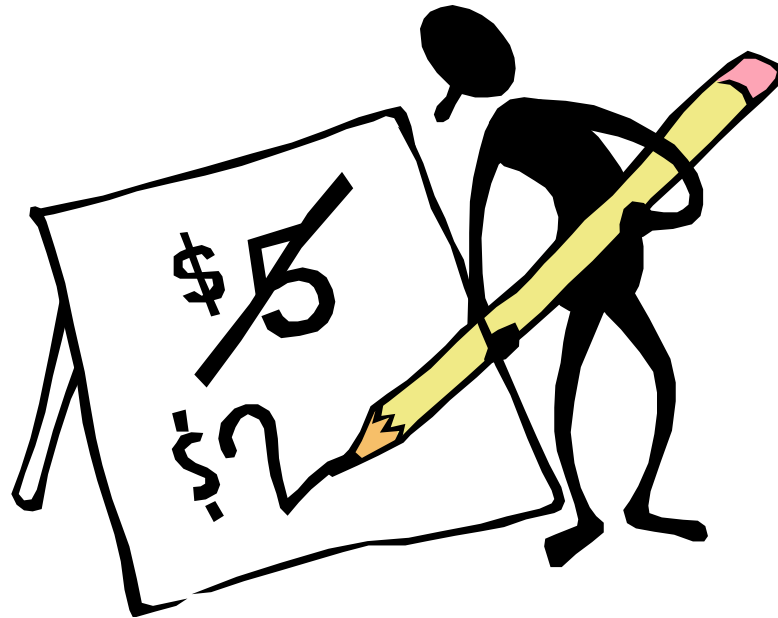
- Natural outgrowth of the reform initiatives of the 1990s (FASA, FARA and ITMRA)
- Beginning calendar Year 1995, NITAAC awarded several Indefinite Delivery vehicles to serve the IT needs of the NIH
- News of the value and effectiveness of using the acquisition vehicles quickly spread
- In September 2000, NIH was designated as an Executive Agent in accordance with the Clinger-Cohen Act

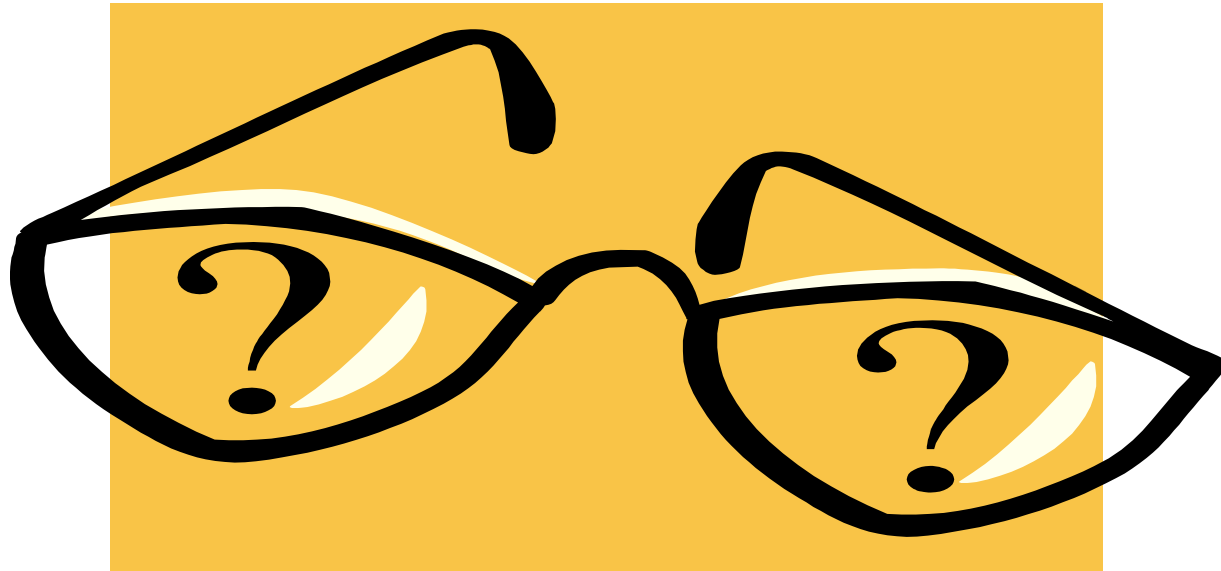
