### Profile

Mr. Purvis recently served as the Chief of Compute Operations at the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA), where he led the agency's data center mission, supporting over 1.5 million users across 11 global locations. He is a seasoned IT professional with extensive experience in Department of Defense (DoD) data center operations, strategic leadership, and mission-critical support.

Under his leadership, several high-profile projects gained agency-wide recognition, including a series of innovative capacity services contracts valued at \$700M over eight years. These contracts were groundbreaking in the government sector, offering flexible and scalable support to Computing Services customers while reducing operational costs. Mr. Purvis earned accolades from both technical publications and multiple levels within the DoD for his achievements.
