Dr. Bart Harmon served as the Director of Information Management and Chief Medical Information Officer for the Military Health System, managed the DoD Health IT investment portfolio, defended the portfolio through the POM process and was Chief Medical Officer for Harris Corporation while they grew an internal health IT start-up to 200M in annual revenue.

Prior to Joining Suss, Dr. Harmon was a clinical and informatics expert on the winning team of the DOD DHMSM Program during the two-year pursuit process. He provided key insights to multiple aspects and phases of the capture for what is estimated to be a multi-billion-dollar program in its end-state.

Dr. Harmon was the Chief Medical Officer for Harris Corporation's Health Solutions business unit, driving the clinical, informatics and Defense Health aspects of the business unit strategy from the stage of internal start-up to 200M per year in revenue.

Prior to this he served as the Director of Information Management for the US Military Health System where was responsible for the Joint portion of the DoD Health Information Technology POM, a 4.8 B dollar portfolio. He also personally briefed and successfully defended the DoD Electronic Health Record project through the Joint Requirements Oversight Council (JROC) process receiving milestone approval for worldwide deployment.

As the DoD Chief Medical Information Officer, he was responsible for the vision, requirements and architectural projects for all Joint DoD Health Information Technology Capabilities, which includes the health care delivery, forward-deployed (theater), health business and health logistics functions and sponsored hundreds of working groups to develop and manage these products. In addition, he frequently represented the vision and need for the product lines to internal and external stakeholders, to include the Joint Staff, military service Surgeon's General, Congressional testimony and Congressional staff interaction, and with the media, the Government Accountability Office and DoD Inspector General investigators.
