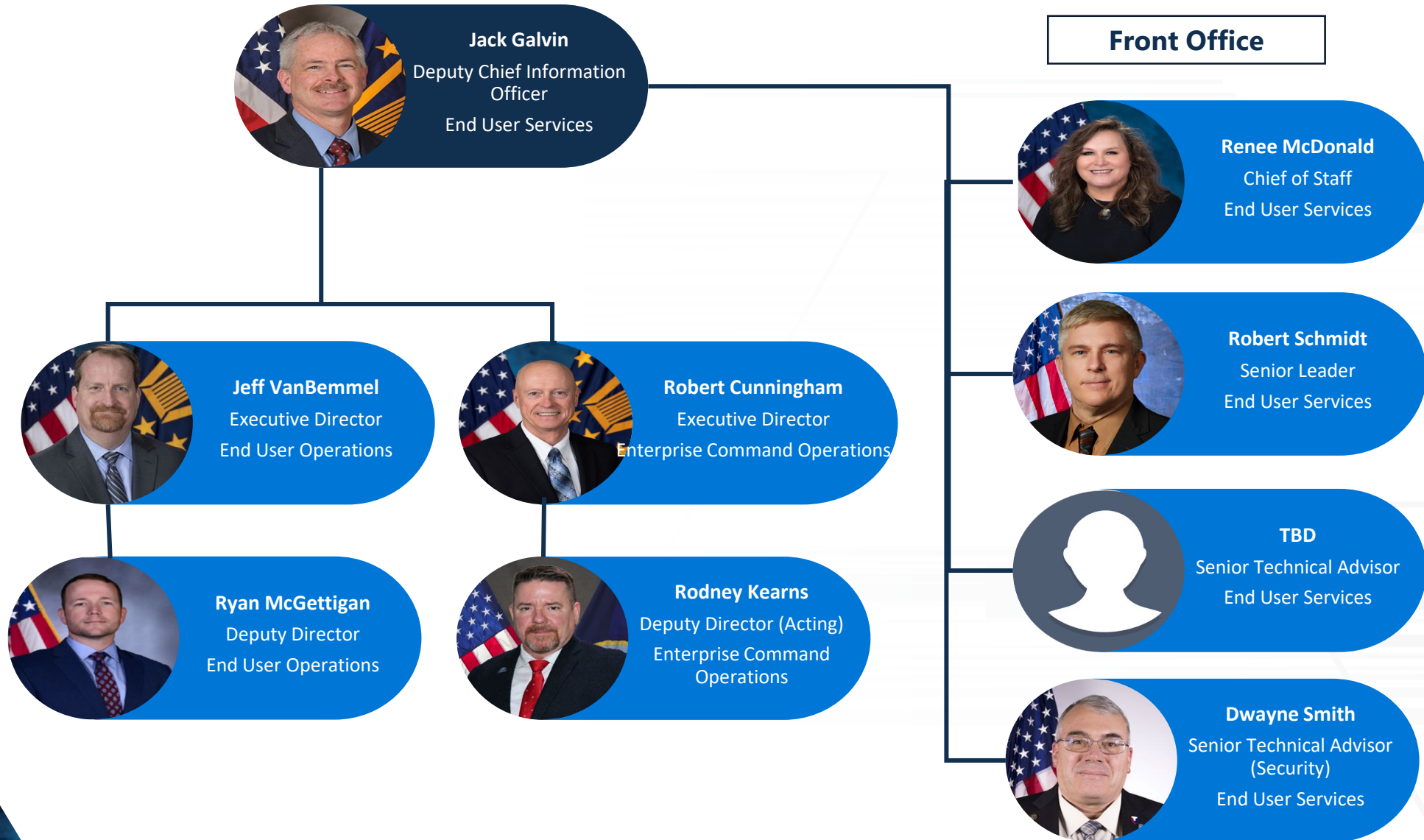

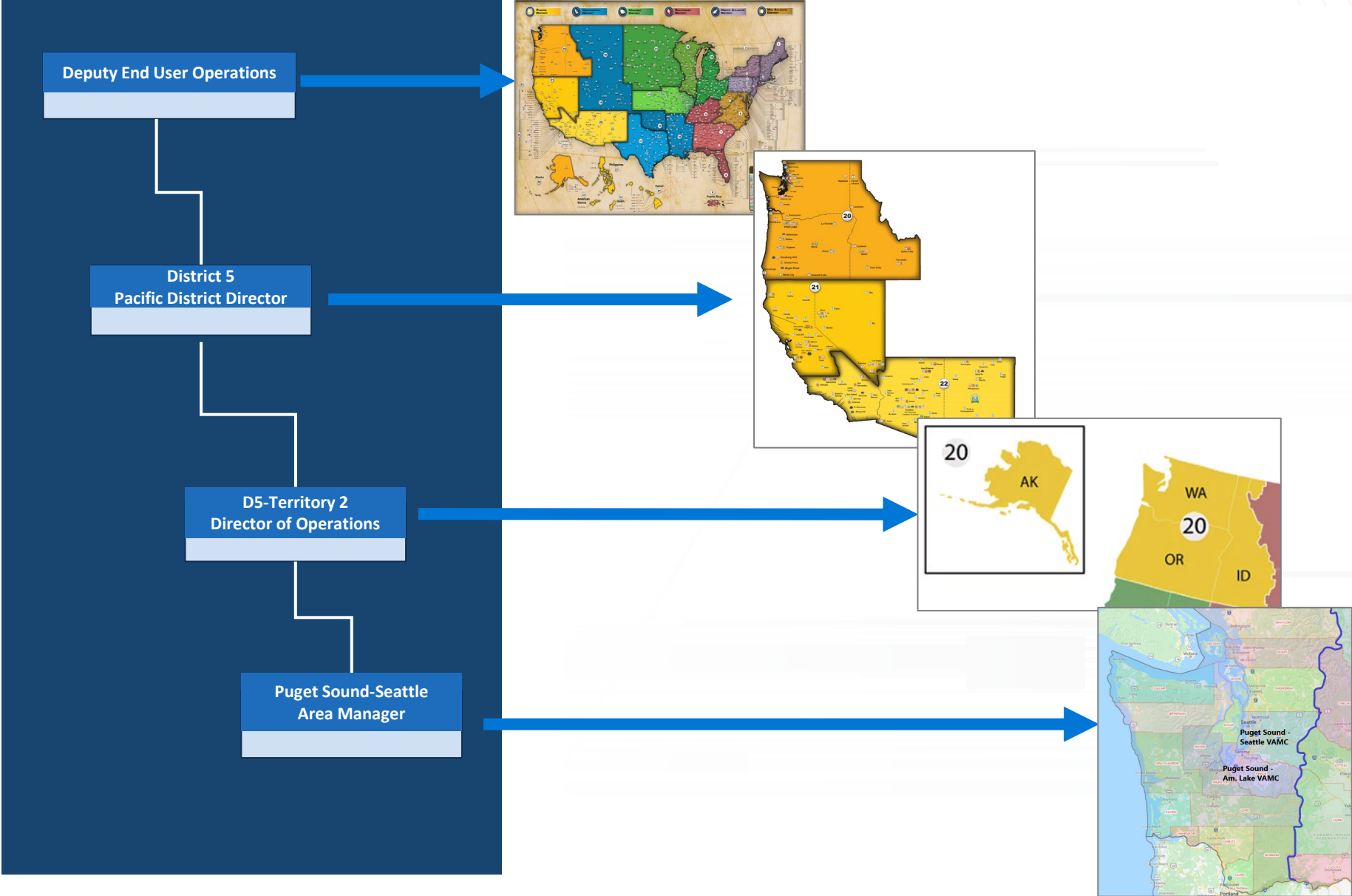

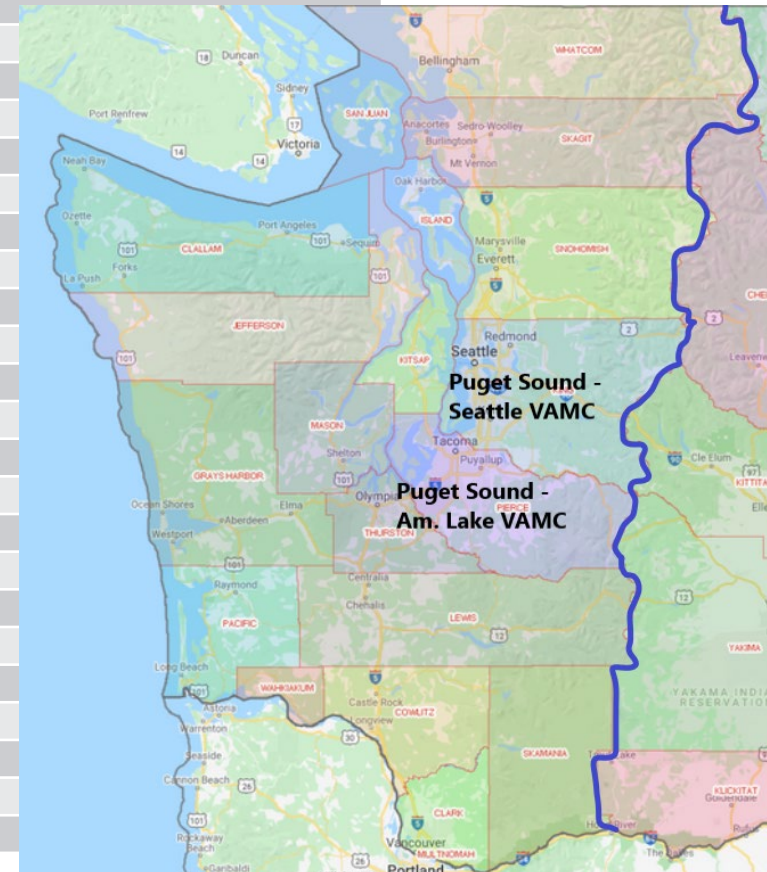
EUS Geographic Leadership Structure



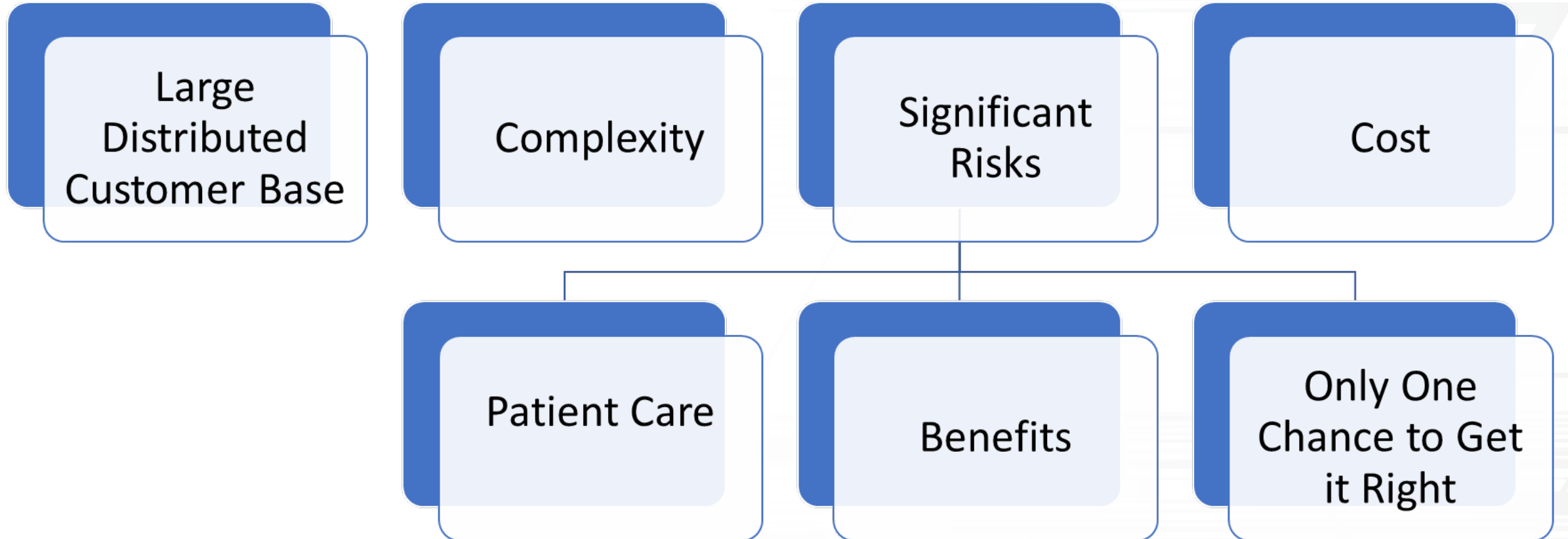
